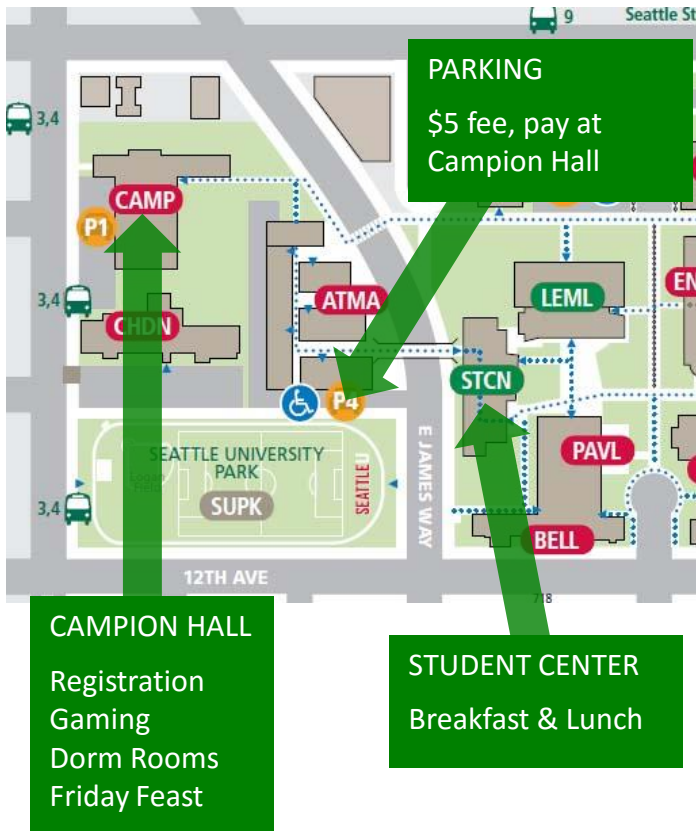


# Go Play NW 2016
